RULES AND PROCEDURES

The private bilingual school Montessori Colors of Toulouse accommodates children starting with nursery and until the end of primary education.

It is characterized on one hand by the choice of Montessori pedagogy, while taking into account the objectives and the criteria of fundamental trainings fixed by the official program of the State of education (elementary classes). And on the other hand, it is a choice of French/English bilingual teaching.

Parents, who registered their child at the school, were informed by the pedagogical team about the Montessori pedagogy, the goals and the means put in work in the school, and accept them.

Any registration implies the understanding of the parents, or legal representatives, of the present rules of procedure.

It is highly recommended to assist or to be present in the teaching briefings (dates will be discussed with you).

Besides these briefings, our team remains available for any question (out of school hours).

The Montessori Colors school accommodates children from 2 to 11 years old.

The possibility of accommodating a child depends on his aptitude in life and community, and on his/her capacity to progress. The acceptance of a child in nursery school is done after a discussion with a teacher, who will judge the relevance of the pupil. Generally, physiological maturity, cleanliness and a basic level of language will be the criteria's of reference for registration.

The candidature of a child having special needs will be studied, considering the capacity of the pedagogical team to meet his/her specific needs, without harming the good performance of the class.

Kindergarten: School time starts at 8:30 until 12:15, then from 13:30 to 16:00, 4 days and half a week (Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday).

We ask students in elementary class to arrive at 8:20.

Wednesday from 9:00 to 12:00 for everybody EXCEPT FOR 2 YEARS OLD CLASSROOM: NO SCHOOL FOR THEM

Children can arrive from 8:15 the morning, and 13:30 in the afternoon. The children can go home from 16:00 from the class or the playground.

Only people authorized by the parents and mentioned in the list in the beginning of the year can pick up a child.

Elementary: School time starts at 8:30 until 12 :00, then from 13:30 to 16:00, 4 days and half a week (Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday). **We ask students in elementary class to arrive at 8:25.**

Wednesday from 9:00 to 12:00.

Children can arrive from 8:20 the morning, and 13:30 in the afternoon. The children can go home from 16:00 from the class or the playground.

Only people authorized by the parents and mentioned in the list in the beginning of the year can pick up a child.

BEFORE AND AFTER SCHOOL CLUB

Kindergarten: A free nursery is organized from 8:20 to 8:30 and 16:00 to 16:15. A paid nursery is proposed from 7:45 to 8:20 and 16:15 to 18:15. (Wednesday 6pm)

Elementary: A free nursery is organized from 8:20 to 8:30 and 16:00 to 16:15.

A paid nursery is proposed from 7:45 to 8:20 and 16:15 to 18:15.(Wednesday 6pm)

Prices : Morning : 2€

Afternoon : 5.5€

We consider the school watch (invoiced in then do the month).

The children left before the opening hours of the nursery or taken after its closing hours are not under the responsibility of the school

PONCTUALITY

Punctuality and assiduity are essential for the good progress of the class: doors will be closed at 8h30. Children won't be accept after this hour.

You will have the possibility to bring your child at 12 :00.

We ask you to be on time in the morning to allow us to accommodate the children individually and also not to disturb the rest of the class. Be also on time in the evening for the respect of everyone.

ABSENCES

The school cannot receive an ill child, feverish (+38°) or carrying a contagious disease. Any absence is consigned every day in a special register held by the teacher.

Any absence must be announced to the school in the morning and must be justified in writing by parents the day of child's return to school.

Please provide a medical certificate in case of prolonged (more than 2 days) or repeated absence.

Starting from 3 years old, learning is obligatory for all the children, therefore the presence of the registered child is essential.

Authorization of absences or early pickups can be granted by the teachers with a written request from the families to answer obligations of exceptional character.

DISEASE

The school does not have the authorization to give medication.

Only the children carrying chronic diseases will be able to see themselves managing pills during school time, within sight of the medical surveillance provided obligatorily by the legal parents or a person in charge of the child.

Any feverish or nauseating state requires a stay at home. The temporarily sick children (general state incompatible with a reception in community) cannot be allowed at the school

In the event of contagious disease, the parents must pick up their child immediately and inform the teachers. With the return, a certificate of non-contagion could be required.

The parents must announce any infectious disease of a family member, as well as any accidents, which have occurred out of the school but concerning the child.

If a child shows any unusual state or has a fever, the parents will be notified immediately.

Throughout the year, it is recommended to be careful with the recrudescence of the lice, to act quickly and effectively and to warn the teachers.

EMERGENCIES

In case of an accident or sickness, the parents are called immediately.

If it happens to be impossible to contact them, the principal calls the Firemen or Samu.

PERSONAL OBJECTS AND CLOTHES

We advise you to mark clothes of your children: gloves, hats, jackets...

The jewellery is disadvised, in case of loss or damage the school will not be held responsible.

The toys from home are not allowed at school, because they can be potentially dangerous for other children.

Teddy is welcome during naptime, but will have to remain in the bag at the entrance of the school for the rest of the day.

LUNCHES

In the Montessori pedagogy, lunch is not a rupture in the course of the day, but, on the contrary, an occasion of a collective sharing and training of rules in life. The children are invited to clean up after themselves afterwards. Meals are delivered every morning by API and warmed by us.

Children may have candies or a cake at school for their birthday, if they wish to.

WEDNESDAYS AFTERNOON

To families who are interested, we propose an extra-curricular time every Wednesday afternoon from 12 :00 to 18:00.

BROKEN MATERIAL

The equipment broken by your child will be invoiced to you.

ADMINISTRATIVE AND FINANCIAL ASPECTS

REGISTRATION

Registration is effective when the subscription form is given (all the required documents are provided in particular, the copies of the book of vaccination, made by the law, and the corresponding sum for the school year by cheque or authorization of taking from your account) will have been given.

TUITION FEES

The payment by cheque of the registration fee as well as a pre-payment of the month of September (without the expenses for the canteen and nursery) is required for the registration or re-registration. This pre-payment will not be refunded to you in case of your leave.

The school fees are contractual and no reduction will be granted in the event of absence of the child.

The regulation of the school fees will be carried out by automatic bank deduction in the first week of each month.

The payment of meals and childcare will be the subject of an invoice correction at each period (every 7/8 weeks), payment will be expected within 8 days by the means at your convenience

The monthly payment lasts for 10 months from September to June. In

July payment of lunches and clubs of June/July and the July week.

Documents requested for registration:

- 1 cheque for the registration fee of 200€ per registered child. (+ a cheque for September and June)
- 1 filled and signed SEPA form, confirming the deduction, with the bank account number.
- These expenses are not refundable in the event of discontinuance.

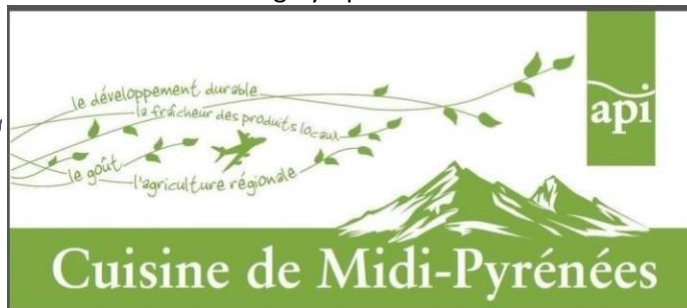

INTERNAL RULES

The entrance to the Montessori Colors School proceeds from a double choice: choice of the school and its pedagogy by the family, choice of families by the School. This double choice founds the relationship between the School and families. It implies adherence to the educational project of the Montessori Colors School to these regulations

SCHEDULES AND ORGANIZATION OF CLASSES

The school welcomes children aged 2 to 11 years old. The pupils of the school are divided into two or three classes: one or two classes for 2-6 year olds (Children's homes), one class for 6-11 year olds (elementary class). The school follows the National Education school holiday calendar.

Out of respect for the work of the children and the educational team, we ask adults to respect the arrival and departure times.

The school welcomes children 4 1/2 days a week: Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday, from 7.45 a.m. to

6.15 p.m. Wednesday from 7.45 a.m. to 6 p.m.

School times for kindergarten students start at 8.30 a.m. and end at 4 p.m. on Wednesdays from 8.45 a.m. to

11.45 a.m. those for elementary classes and 8.30 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Wednesdays from 8.45 a.m. to 11.45 a.m.

HOME

The reception of kindergarten children takes place every morning between 7.45 am and 8.30 am only.

The reception of elementary school children takes place every morning between 7.45 am and 8.30 am only.

Each child enrolled in school remains under the responsibility of his / her parents or the responsible adult accompanying him / her until he / she is physically inside the building and taken care of by a member of the educational team.

DELAY

Any delay being detrimental to the proper functioning of the school, the doors will close at 8.30 am sharp. As the school does not have full-time paid administrative staff, it cannot be reopened for late arrivals before the lunch break, at 12 :00 a.m.

However, in case of justified delay, it will be possible to call the school before it closes to agree on a possible reopening schedule.

It is extremely important, and asked all parents, to understand the importance of this punctuality and to respect it.

ABSENCES

EXIT DURING SCHOOL TIME:

We ask families to please arrange medical and other appointments outside of school hours. If this is not possible, it is easier for the child to be absent for half a day. If the meeting takes place in the morning, he can arrive at school at 11.45 am. If the appointment takes place in the afternoon, he can leave school at 12:30 p.m.

As defined in the education code, the school attendance obligation consists of participating in school work, respecting teaching hours, as well as the collective rules of each establishment.

The planned absence of a child, regardless of the class in which he is enrolled, must imperatively be reported orally to the educator concerned at the latest the day before it and recorded by email at the direction.

In the event of an unforeseen absence, this must be reported as soon as possible by the parents by telephone on 05 61 41 31 85 or 06 21 62 70 90 or by email: montessoricolors@gmail.com

A medical certificate will be given when the child returns in the event of illness.

In case of travel an email / post as well as a copy of the airline tickets will be requested in order to comply with the regulations of the National Education regarding compulsory education.

EXIT FROM CLASSES

Classes leave at 4:00 p.m. It is done by the entrance gate.

As soon as a parent or a person duly authorized by the parents comes to pick him up, the child is under his full responsibility, even within the school grounds.

Parents are therefore asked to ensure respect for the equipment, the environment and the neighbourhood.

Only persons registered on the "list of persons entitled to pick up a child" provided by each family are authorized to pick up a child with an identity document.

However, in the event that the intended person is unable to pick up a child, another person may be authorized, provided that the legal guardian of the child notifies the management of the school by email (montessoricolors@gmail.com). An identity document may be requested.

Otherwise, the child will be cared for according to the rules of the nursery until the arrival of a duly authorized person. It is therefore strongly advised to include on the said list a parent from the school who can take care of exceptionally welcoming your child.

Procedure for not taking care of your child after school

For information, in the event that no authorized person comes to pick up a child at the end of the day-care (6:15 p.m.) and without news from the parents, the day-care manager will notify the school principal. She will in turn try to reach parents or duly authorized persons. If there is no response, she will pick up the child from school and take him to the nearest police or gendarmerie service. She will then notify the parents of the child's whereabouts by telephone and email.

NURSERY

A paid day-care service is provided on school days from 7:45 a.m. to 8:15 a.m. and from 4:15 p.m. until 6:15 p.m.

Fees will be charged for the delay: € 5 for a departure at 6:20 p.m., then € 2 / minute late until 6.30 p.m., then

€ 5 / minute (price per child always present in the school)

No child or parent is allowed inside the school after the school closes (6.15 p.m.) except for meetings and shows.

HYGIENE AND SAFETY

EXIT CLASS

When registering, by signing this charter, the parents agree to authorize the child to participate in all activities taking place outside the school grounds, under the responsibility of the educators.

If necessary, parent volunteers can accompany a group of children on outings.

SECURITY

As in all public establishments, the following are prohibited at school:

- dangerous objects (sharp, sharp, flammable, etc.)
- weapons or toys imitating weapons

No adult, apart from parents, members of the teaching staff or speakers, is allowed on the premises of the establishment. The same is true for children not in school.

EVACUATION EXERCISES

To prevent the risk of fire and intrusion, evacuation drills will be held regularly.

Hygiene rules

In general, children must be clean when they arrive at school, unless there is an unforeseeable accident. For the sake of simplicity, a stock of spare clothes in different sizes is present at school so that the team can change a child in the event of an accident. Parents should return these washed clothes to school as soon as possible. A complete replacement in a plastic bag should be placed in the child's satchel.

Disease

All sick and / or contagious children must be kept at home.

The introduction of medicines (including homeopathic medicines) into the school grounds is strictly prohibited.

Vaccinations

Parents must provide a photocopy of the "vaccinations" page of the child's health record, which must be up to date with reminders.

Health check-ups:

In France, two health checks are compulsory during nursery and primary schooling. The first must take place during the child's sixth year, and the second during the ninth year. In public schools, they are often carried out by school medical services. The Montessori Colors School does not have a medical service, but is nevertheless required to ensure this medical follow-up. We therefore ask families to have these visits carried out by a city doctor and to provide the school with a medical certificate attesting that the assessment mentioned was carried out by a health professional. The 6-year exam is particularly important because it includes the early detection of signs that can lead to later learning difficulties: visual, hearing, language problems

Lice

Children with lice should be treated. You are asked to notify a member of the teaching team as soon as possible to prevent their spread and if possible tie the hair.

Nap

A nap time is provided for children who still need it. Provide blanket and pillow, marked with the child's name.

COMMUNICATION WITH FAMILIES

The Montessori School of Colors wishes to promote communication between parents and educators on the basis of shared trust and mutual respect in the name of the child's well-being. In order to build this trust, we offer:

- A collective meeting at the beginning of the year to present each class, our pedagogy.
 - an annual individual interview to talk about each child and their development.
- For children schooling in 2-3-6 years and 6-11 years, these interviews take place during the four educational days, the dates of which are communicated at the beginning of the year. Children are admitted to school until noon during these days. These are usually Fridays before Halloween, Christmas, February and Easter. Families can also request an appointment with members of the education team or with management at any time. These meetings can also be requested by the educational team.

Equipment

Any equipment broken / damaged by a child will

be invoiced to his family. Life at School

Pedagogy and Cooperation

Children must imperatively benefit from independent and uninterrupted activity time (individual or group for the oldest), every morning and afternoon. This organization allows the respect of the rhythm of work, the possibility of the free choice of the activity and the concentration of the child in his task.

Your children need consistency between the support offered at school and that within each family. This is why parents will be invited at the beginning of the school year during the educational meeting to a presentation of the characteristics of Montessori pedagogy for the age group concerned, in order to better understand how their children live the class on a daily basis and organize home life in the same direction.

SCHOOL LIFE

The teaching team meets to discuss and debate both the organization of work in a class and the difficulties encountered by a particular child. School plays a vital role in the child's life: we do everything in our power to encourage their development. Children's freedom is at the center of our work. It is not an external freedom, but an internal freedom which is built through independent activity, respect for the rhythm and the interests of the child. Thanks to Montessori pedagogy, discipline and freedom no longer vary in the opposite direction. More freedom is not less discipline and vice versa, on the contrary! When the behavior of a child seriously and permanently disrupts the functioning of the group and reflects an obvious maladjustment of the child to the life of the class, the situation of this child will be submitted to the educational team for examination. A decision to arrange school time (half-time shift for example) or to permanently withdraw from school can be taken by the director, after an interview with the parents.

Celebrations

Birthdays will be celebrated on the last Friday of each month. Parents can bring a cake with candles. Clothes and Personal Objects

It is mandatory to mark your child's clothes and accessories. Unmarked and unclaimed clothing will be donated to charitable organizations during each vacation period.

We also ask you that a rain suit remains permanently in the locker room, namely: rain boots, K-way and rain pants (marked with your child's name), all in a small bag (also in his name). These outfits are to be brought home and washed at each vacation or if they are very dirty. Slippers are compulsory and must be worn in classes for kindergarten students.

In general, please dress your child in clothes that are not very fragile, practical and comfortable corresponding to the weather of the day! Avoid overalls and lace-up shoes, think of facilitating the autonomy of your child who must be able to do it by himself.

For obvious reasons, the following are also prohibited:
- valuables (jewelry, money, etc.),

- sweets and candies,

-the toys

Socialization and behavior of children

A Montessori atmosphere offers an adapted environment which promotes by experience the revelation of each child in the real world and not in a sterile bubble free of any risk.

In addition, as part of his socialization, the child learns to live with and in contact with the other. During this learning phase, it is not abnormal that blows, bites or insults are exchanged. However, these behaviors are not tolerated. These situations are taken care of and resolved within the educational team.

The playground is not a sanitized bubble. It represents a natural, flourishing environment which is not without danger.

In the case of inappropriate behavior of the child, a multi-step procedure will be implemented by the educational team:

1st stage: discussion with the child (conflict resolution) / apologies / calm time

2nd step: request for a return the next day of information to the parents resulting in an awareness of the child and a discussion with the parents.

3rd step: interview between family,

educators and management 4th

step: education council to consider

continuing schooling.

VIOLENCE AND LACK OF RESPECT

We all work with respect for everyone and we hope it is the same on the part of parents registering their child in our establishment and we want to prioritize communication.

Thus, any verbal and / or physical violence on the part of a parent on a school staff will be immediately sanctioned by a complaint filed with the authorities, the permanent withdrawal of the child from school, the immediate payment of the rest of schooling.

PASSING IN THE ELEMENTARY CLASS

The transition from kindergarten to elementary class 6-- - 12 of the Montessori Colors School takes place when the child is ready and has acquired the necessary maturity.

Concerning children who are not yet of the required age (6 years) for a passage in elementary class and whose parents wish an early passage in higher class. The educational team is the decision-maker after reading the assessment of a psychologist going in this direction and meeting with the parents.

PAYMENTS

At the beginning of each month, the payment of the tuition is due by direct debit. Every 8 weeks an amending invoice will be sent including the payment for meals and daycare used for the previous 7 weeks. The settlement of this invoice will be expected within 8 days by the means at your convenience (cash, check, direct debit).

SUSPENSION / TERMINATION OF THE CONTRACT

Payment for the school year is considered due from the signing of this contract. The school year is not understood in terms of days or weeks of work. Thus, no hazard beyond our control (epidemic, pandemic, administrative closure, etc.) causing the temporary closure of the establishment will result in a decrease in monthly education, we will do our best to provide educational follow-up.

Consider having a childcare arrangement (family, nanny, etc.) in case your child cannot be welcomed into the establishment (sick child, sick staff).

REMOVALS / DISMISSAL
